How do we feel about prayer?

Some people would answer that they have great faith in prayer and pray all the time. Others would say that they feel prayer doesn't really work and so they don't do it, or pray only very briefly. Some of us will consider prayer as a last option. If there are other options, we will most likely pick those first. Our downfall is probably that our approach to prayer is all wrong. We approach God with a kind of shopping list of all the things we feel we need. We approach God with prayers that are foolish! Worse, we try to bargain with God, promising that we will go to church more often if only he will sort out our problems. "Ask and it will be given you; search and you will find; knock and he door will be opened for you..." It would be wonderful to believe these words, but before we believe them we really need to understand them. It's clear that we need to know what to pray for and how to pray.

Today Jesus gives us a prayer: "The Lord's Prayer". But he isn't just giving us a prayer to recite. What he is giving us is a model on which to base our own prayers. In the Lord's Prayer we are invited to pray to God as our Father, acknowledging his holiness and praying with the shared commitment to have his will done on earth. We are invited to pray for our 'daily bread' the things we genuinely need. Lastly, we should approach God with the faith we approach a loving parent. Even parents with very average parenting skills know how to give children what they need. "How much more," says Jesus, "will the father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask...."


